VUEWorks 2019 Award Program

The VUEWorks 2019 National Award Program for Asset Management is being offered by Data Transfer Solutions as a recognition to our valued clients who have utilized the VUEWorks application in the lifecycle management of their assets. The four awards recognize innovation, return on investment through cost-risk-performance, best practices-standards and community impact. Each award is reflective of good leadership, dedication to the goal of excellence, hard work and a good set of asset management tools.

The awards program is a great way for your organization to show what can be done in asset management, in government agencies or in the private sector. Entry for the awards can be completed by the organization applying or by a DTS employee nominating a client for the award. Below are the four awards offered and a brief description of each.

Innovation

VUEWorks projects, processes or programs that demonstrate new techniques or innovative approaches to asset management best practice at any or all of its life cycle stages. This award will be given to the organization that has shown great ingenuity in managing their assets using technology and tools. This award will recognize creative use of the VUEWorks module(s) to accomplish company and industry goals.

Cost Risk Performance – Return on Investment

Projects or programs demonstrating the balance between the elements of cost, risk and performance to obtain a valuable solution for an asset. This award will be given to the organization that has demonstrated the use of their asset management program to manage costs and risks to improve overall performance and realize a return on their asset management investment. The ROI can be measured in actual dollar savings, resource efficiencies and/or time savings.

Best Practices - Standards

Organizations or projects that demonstrate the use of good data governance, best practice initiatives and implementation of standards around asset management will be great candidates for this award. This award will be given to the organization that has demonstrated strong asset management maturity in the areas of naming standards, SOPs, asset lifecycle documentation and reporting as well as asset condition management.

Environment or Community Impact

Projects which demonstrate a solution to an identified community need which was solved using asset management principles and the VUEWorks Asset Management solution. This award will consider the impact on citizens and the community involved, environmental factors, and profit or value delivered to the community through services or organization.

Note: Applicants can apply for more than one award in each of the above (4) categories. Awarding in each category will be at the discretion of the Judging Panel and one award will be given in each category unless the judges deem more than one of the applicants are worthy of that recognition. Judge's decisions are final.

Eligibility

The following criteria for eligibility are:

- The nominee or applicant must be a VUEWorks client in good standing.
- The project or program enhancement should have been completed in the last two years preceding the application deadline date.
- The service must be sustainable and operational at the time of nomination.
- No project or service is too large or too small. The overall impact of the solution to the organization will be considered.

Assessment of Categories for Award Scoring

Use of the VUEWorks application as part of the solution - 40%

Although other applications can be a part of the solution, VUEWorks needs to be at least 50% of the technical component for the solution or program or project submitted.

Program and project development maturity – 30%

Quality and depth of the project or program will be considered a part of the assessment. Organization within the solution, documentation and supporting tools for management of the program or project.

Plus, one of the following award areas:

Innovation - degree of originality and ingenuity of solution – 30%

Explain how innovative approaches have been used in achieving asset management at the organization. Highlight bold ideas, achievements, challenges and lessons learned. Or demonstrate how innovation has been achieved through leveraging technology tools, experiences, and creative thinking.

or

ROI – Completeness of the program around Cost/Risk/Performance – 30%

Explain the details around the project or program that demonstrate the balance between the elements of cost, risk and performance to obtain a measurable return on investment. This award will be given to the organization that has demonstrated the use of their asset management program to manage costs and risks, to improve overall performance, and realize a return on their asset management investment. The ROI can be measured in actual dollar savings, resource efficiencies and/or time savings.

or

Best Practices - Use of standardization for asset management – 30%

Explain the details around the projects or programs that demonstrate the use of good data governance, best practice initiatives and implementation of standards around asset management. Clarify how the organization has demonstrated strong asset management maturity in the areas of naming standards, SOPs, asset lifecycle documentation and reporting as well as asset condition management.

or

Community Impact - Benefit to the environment or community – 30%

Explain the project or program that provided a solution to an identified community need which was solved using asset management principles and the VUEWorks Asset Management solution. Include the impact on citizens and the community involved, environmental factors, and profit or value delivered to the community through services or organization.
